

RECYCLING INFORMATION

The following items are recyclable – PLEASE rinse non-paper products:

- Newspapers, Magazines, Catalogs, Telephone Books, Mail, Cards
- Aluminum and tin cans
- Plastic milk and water jugs, Plastic soda bottles (numbers 1 and 2)
- Glass bottles and jars
- Cardboard and Chipboard (like cereal boxes), clean paper egg cartons
- All small plastic food containers, such as condiment bottles and yogurt cups

Please note that glass, cardboard, chipboard, catalogs, and small plastic food containers are acceptable. Please fold down cardboard boxes flat and place next to or inside the carts. Large cardboard boxes (such as for appliances) should be broken down or put out with regular trash. Residents should also thoroughly rinse all aluminum, tin, glass, and plastic containers before placing them in the recycling bin to avoid contamination.

Items that are NOT recyclable include:

*Plastic shrink wrap and bags, plastic film, and Styrofoam. (Some grocery stores accept used plastic bags for recycling)

*Any containers that contained engine oil, anti-freeze, or other chemicals of a similar nature, Paper towels, Light bulbs, mirrors, ceramics, scrap metals, aerosol cans, plates, plastic wrap, butter bowls. Any cardboard or paper products which have been contaminated with food (such as pizza boxes or fast food containers)
